

Each refugee/asylum seeker gets 3 meals a day, a room and £8 per week to live on. None are allowed to work — and some struggle with language. Many are professionals mostly males. Restrictions imposed via Home Office are impacting on the refugee/asylum seekers ref pressure/routine/boredom. Discussion by members. Damien offered discos/quizs for free if that would help. Some of the refugee/asylum seekers have worked with Colin in the community garden — and they are up for volunteering.
